“What you need and when you need it”

Band Camp

There is no band camp “uniform”. Wear cool comfortable clothes and lace up tennis shoes.

No uniform required for Band Camp performance on Saturday of Band Camp.

Full Uniform fittings during band camp - starting with Seniors and ending with Freshmen (probably at the end of the week or during Tuesday/Thursday Band Rehearsals after band camp). Fitting times will be scheduled. Each day of band camp a list will be posted in the band room with the following day’s names and times listed.

_____ Black Marching shoes - can be purchased at Rush’s/Lunsfords - Drill Masters - write name on inside of both shoes

_____ 3 pair of white gloves with Velcro fasteners at wrists for Freshmen/New Students). Gloves will be labeled with the students name and “checked in “and left in uniform room. (Exceptions: percussion - no gloves, front ensemble - only need 1 pair)

(Returning students - a list showing how many pairs of gloves you need to bring will be posted in the band room)

Compression gear is not required at this time. Private dressing areas are provided during fittings. However, bibbers cannot be tried on over regular shorts. They can be tried on over underwear. If you are not comfortable with that, please bring compression shorts. Jackets can be fit over t-shirts.

Warm Weather Uniform - needed by first football game performance

_____ Show shirt - handed out at band camp

_____ Khaki colored shorts with belt loops- appropriate length (school dress code)

Percussion wear black shorts - check with section leader

_____ Belt for shorts - shirts worn tucked in

_____ Tennis shoes and socks of choice

Full Uniform - needed around the 3rd or 4th football game - date set each year by band directors and usually dependent on temperature. This will be announced ahead of time.

_____ White compression shirt - short sleeves - may want to switch to long sleeves with colder weather

_____ Black or dark colored compression shorts - may want to switch to long compression gear with colder weather

_____ Tall solid black dress socks

_____ Black marching shoes

_____ Accessories to put any long hair up inside hat - pony tail holders, bobby pins, non-shiny hair clips, etc.

NOTE: *Tuba players* will need to purchase black beret - check with section leader

Saxophone players will need to purchase a separate new strap that will stay in their hat box for performances
